Truth & Reconciliation Commitment

As part of our ongoing commitment to Truth & Reconciliation Lord Beaverbrook High School, led by grade 10, 11 and 12 leadership students, have created a prominent display that honours Survivors, their families, and communities. This display consists of 215 pairs of children's shoes, each of which will symbolically represent one of the 215 children confirmed to be buried at the former Kamloops Indian Residential School in May 2021.

To support with this project, we are asking for donations of new or like-new children's footwear. Donations can be brought to the main office. We will be seeking the advice of Indigenous Elders to determine how long the display should remain. When the time comes to take it down, the shoes will be donated to local organizations who provide clothing to Indigenous youth in need.

Students on an Individualized Program Plan

MJ Sorensen does an amazing coordinating all the Individual Program Plans. She works out of a space called "The Learning Lounge" (room 108). If your student was a CBE student last year, all of the assessments, diagnosis, previous accommodations and strategies transfer to us and are visible to all their teachers. If you are new to CBE and have provided documentation from your previous school, that has been entered and is visible to all their teachers. Students requiring accommodations for exams (reader or voice typing for essays) should communicate that directly with their teachers, who set it up with me in the learning lounge. Teachers will be discussing accommodations and successful strategies with your student over the next few weeks. They will set a goal for the semester for the IPP. The main IPP goal in high school is for students to start advocating for their learning needs by communicating with their teacher. The IPP will be handed out on Friday October 13 for your review, changes, and additions. Student conferences are on Thursday October 19 (evening) and Friday October 20. I look forward to supporting your student this year. If there are any questions or concerns, please have your student come see MJ in The Learning Lounge.
